

TRIMONT COUNCIL MINUTES

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, an Emergency meeting was duly held at the Trimont Community Building, and via Zoom, on the 9th day of June, 2020 at 6:30 o'clock P.M.

The following members were present: Mayor Troy Schmidtke, Council Member Sterling Adamson, Council Member Thomas Hage, Council Member Bruce Borntrager, and Council Member Brian Krumwiede.

Mayor Troy Schmidtke presided over the meeting.

The meeting was called to order to discuss employment matters in the public works department.
