

Trimont City Council Minutes

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a Special Meeting meeting was duly held at the Trimont Community Building on the 6th day of June, 2023 at 5:30 o'clock P.M.

The following members were present: Council Member Brian Krumwiede, Council Member Bradford Flohrs, Council Member Bruce Borntreger, Council Member Jon Holtz, Mayor JoAnn Russenberger

Mayor JoAnn Russenberger presided over the meeting.

SEH:

Overview on where we are with the infrastructure & pond project. Fall of 2019 is when we first met about this project.

Would like to add a water tower. Going to check on the inspection report from 2021 from Maguire Iron.

Discussion on a filtration system needed such as an R/O or lime softening. Main St (the county road) is on the schedule for milling in 2027. The city would also like to add a Jetter pit to the pond. For easy disposal from the jetter truck. Discussion on the priority sequence. Would have to reduce I/I before we can build the ponds as we have to be within the permittable limits, prior to the build. Otherwise, the ponds would have to be bigger to accommodate the higher I/I.

Discussion on locking in the farmland. Next step will be to have letters go out to the neighbors to let them know what is happening with this project. **Motion made by Council Member Bruce Borntreger, seconded by Council Member Jon Holtz. Motion carried, to approve Duluth Archaeology to survey the east property for the archeological study. 5-0**

Resolution 2023-11:

Authorizing the City Clerk / Treasurer to file an application with the Minnesota Management and Budget office for the purpose of water improvements, wastewater facility improvements. **Motion made by Council Member Bruce Borntreger, seconded by Council Member Bradford Flohrs. Motion carried, to approve Resolution 2023-11. 5-0**

Mower:

The zero turn motor is shelled out. **Motion made by Council Member Bruce Borntreger, seconded by Council Member Brian Krumwiede. Motion carried, to approve to fix mower. 5-0**

Regular Meeting moved to June 20th.

Amend motion for mower to get fixed. **Motion made by Council Member Brian Krumwiede, seconded by Council Member Jon Holtz. Motion carried, to approve to put new motor in for up to \$3500. 5-0**

Police Squad Tires:

Discussion on new tires for the squad. **Motion made by Council Member Brian Krumwiede, No second, Motion failed, for Borntreger for new Tires \$844.50.**

Further discussion. **Motion made by Council Member Brian Krumwiede, seconded by Council Member Jon Holtz. Motion tied, to approve up to \$800 for new tires on squad.** Council Member Borntreger abstained. **2-2** Further discussion on a better-quality tire. **Motion made by Council Member Bradford Flohrs, get more bids.** Council Member Borntreger stated its maintenance we don't need approval. The chief will get the tires replaced. Discussion on a schedule from Police department. Chief will continue to keep changing it up & work some weekends. County is responsible if he is out.

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Clean up day:

This Saturday in Martin county clean up. There has been confusion if the clean up fee on the utility bills is for curbside clean up. After reviews past records & minutes. It was not created for the curbside clean up. It is stated as property cleanup and demolition. Change the wording to read City Preservation for more clarity.

Unlawful Discharge Fee:
